This information sheet shows the results of the inaugural **Times Higher Education University Impact Rankings** for your institution. The data is broken down by SDG, and by metrics within the SDG. Details on the metrics and the methodology can be found online at TimesHigherEducation.com, and in the attached poster.

Scores presented here represent the raw scores for each SDG table. In order to ensure that SDGs were treated equally when calculating the overall University Impact Rankings, the scores were rescaled across the full range (up to 100) before the overall score was calculated. The overall score is calculated by taking the score for SDG 17 (worth 22%) and the scores for your three best other SDGs after normalisation (each worth 26%). Universities outside the top 100 (both overall, and for each SDG) are placed into bands, and their score given as a range. Where no score or rank is provided an institution did not submit data for that SDG. If fewer than four SDGs were provided, or if SDG 17 was omitted, then no overall score or rank is available.
